- A serious injury occurred when a diesel fired truck mounted heater over pressured causing a valve failure. The resulting discharge of hit water/steam struck a worker knocking them into an adjacent parked vehicle. Preliminary findings revealed procedural anomalies and the fact that the heater was not equipped with over pressure protection.
- As reported that there have been incidents of failure to use fall protection. The current standards are being reviewed.
